The Cincinnati Chapter of the American Association of Blacks in Energy announces its Scholarship Opportunities for 2015 graduating high school seniors.

- Students who have at least a "C" high school academic average are welcome to apply. Students with a "C" average must complete the Local Scholarship Application Checklist for "C" average only.
 - > Students with a "C" academic average are not required to major in a particular field.
- Students who have, minimally, an overall "B" unweighted academic average (3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale).
 - > Students with minimally, an overall "B" unweighted academic average must plan to major in business, one of the physical sciences, technology, engineering or mathematics fields in preparation for a career in the energy sector.

(If you have a "B" or better but are **not majoring in the required fields**, see 'Note' on bottom of our "Local Checklist")

Additional Eligibility:

- Be a graduating high school senior enrolled in a local private or public school who has applied to one or more accredited colleges/universities.
- Be a member of one of a class or group of individuals who has been historically underrepresented in the sciences, technology, engineering and math related disciplines.

The application deadline is Saturday, March 27, 2015.

Scholarship awards from the Cincinnati AABE chapter range from \$500 to \$1500. The Regional Award is \$3,000, and the Premier Award is \$5,000. Guidelines, applications and checklists are attached.

We encourage you to invite high school seniors you know to apply.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION AND GUIDELINES

The American Association of Blacks in Energy is a professional organization of African Americans in the energy industry. Through its Scholarship Program, AABE seeks to help increase the number of African Americans, Hispanics and Native Americans (underrepresented minorities) in energy related fields. By doing so, we help our nation address a critical need and a challenge to our future economic vitality in the world market.

Eligibility

Candidates for an AABE scholarship must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Have, minimally, an overall "B" unweighted academic average (3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale).
- Be a graduating high school senior who has applied to one or more accredited colleges/universities.
- Plan to major in business, one of the physical sciences, technology, engineering or mathematics fields in preparation for a career in the energy sector.
- Be a member of one of a class or group of individuals who has been historically underrepresented in the sciences, technology, engineering and math related disciplines.

Selection

Scholarship recipients - known as AABE Scholars - are determined each spring by the organization's local chapter scholarship committee for local scholarships and by the National Scholarship Committee for national scholarships. Recipients receive notification of their selection.

Awards

The Cincinnati Chapter of AABE will award Local Chapter Scholarships. The top winner's application is forwarded to compete for a Midwest Regional Award of \$3,000 (The Midwest Region is one of six AABE Regions). Additionally, a "Rufus D. Gladney" Premier Award of \$5,000 is given annually to the candidate who is judged to demonstrate the most outstanding achievement and promise. National Awards are made to the students upon presentation of proof of enrollment at an accredited college or university. Distribution of local chapter awards are made at the discretion of the local chapter upon proof of enrollment at an accredited college or university.

The Application Package

Consideration will be given only to candidates submitting <u>complete</u> application packages which include: (1) a completed AABE application form (copies are acceptable); (2) an official high school transcript; (3) official proof of ACT or SAT scores; (4) two letters of reference; and (5) a completed checklist. <u>Please redact Social Security Numbers from any documents</u>.

Complete application packages <u>MUST BE POSTMARKED</u> NO LATER THAN March 27, 2015 and submitted to the local AABE chapter listed below. Applications returned to the AABE national office or the National Scholarship Committee is in violation of procedures and will not be considered for scholarship support.

Your signature below signifies you have checked each line above and therefore affirm each statement. After signing, attach this form to the front of your application. Applications will not be reviewed without the checklist attached. Any omissions or misrepresentations of the truth will be grounds for disqualification.
